

# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

## SHOW JUMPING & DRESSAGE



1. All riders must wear approved protective hard hats to BRC rules. please visit <http://www.wyhp.co.uk/wp-content/uploads/2018/01/2018-BRC-Hat-Tagging-Guide.pdf> to check your hat's eligibility
2. All competitors must be correctly dressed
3. Any non BRC members must ensure they have adequate insurance
4. Objections must be raised by lodging £10 with the Secretary, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
5. Excess cruelty to horse or pony will result in disqualification
6. Horses and Ponies will be considered to be 'in the charge of the competitors' and the committee will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury owing to accident or any other cause
7. Age to count on the day
- 8 Competitors in lead rein classes may not compete in other ridden classes off the lead rein on the day.
9. Jumping classes will not be delayed for competitors in other classes (competitors may be able to leave showing classes to jump)
- 10 We reserve the right to change, cancel or amend any class without prior notice
11. Once an entry has been made no refund will be given unless the place can be taken up by another team or individual.
12. The organisers and Committee reserve the right to alter or cancel any class at their discretion and request any competitor to remove from the competition any animal which is thought to be unfit to compete for any reason whatsoever. Their decision is final.
13. All horses or ponies must be 4 years old or older on 1<sup>st</sup> Jan this year.
14. Owners entering their horses/ponies do so entirely at their own risk. West Yorkshire Horseplay Officials and Members accept no liability of any kind in respect of any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, ponies, owners, grooms, ground spectator or any other person or property whatsoever.
15. The Organisers of the event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and Stewards.
16. Any person entering who is not a BRC member should have their own liability insurance.
17. Stallions must wear a stallion disk on each side of the bridle at all times and competitor must ensure that other competitors, ponies and horses and members of the public are not put at any risk. Please refer to BRC handbook for any other guidance.

### LEGAL LIABILITY

Save of the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event or which these rules apply, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars their contents & accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.

### HEALTH & SAFETY

The organisers of the event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of all persons & horse/ponies. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and the officials and stewards.
